## **Treasurer's Report:**

\$10,517.29 in the savings account. \$1,351.49 in the checking account. The CD is still \$26,283.98 since the interest is only added once a year.

There was a discussion regarding the extra time spent collecting homeowner's dues when they are not paid on time. Bill Boardman made a motion to add a \$10 late fee if the dues are not paid in full by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Sharon Desaulniers seconded the motion. The board hopes this will encourage homeowners to pay more quickly. Ron Ramieri asked about a logo for the bills. Diane Currier advised she would check to see if the Quicken program could add a logo to the bills.

## **Architectural Review Board:**

## **Covenants Committee:**

An anonymous complaint was received regarding a house on Kings Ridge doing working on cars in their garage. The covenants committee does not act on unsigned complaints. The board received a second signed complaint regarding the commercial vehicle parked on Long View Ct. The complaint was turned over to Bob Cruz on the covenants committee for action. Rick Kasper offered to write the draft letter to be sent out to the homeowner.

## **Ground Committee:**
